# 2021 - 2022 Upper School Contract

# The Capitol School offers three options for payment of tuition. Please mark your choice:

Option #1 – Parents/guardians pay the annual tuition in one lump sum of \$10,920 tuition plus \$275 fees due July 1.

#### OR

Option #2 – Parents/guardians pay the tuition monthly by bank draft. The cost of this option through bank draft includes 4% interest on tuition.

\$11,357 tuition & \$275 fees = \$1,208 for 10 months

### OR

Option #3 – Parents/guardians pay the tuition monthly by *credit card*. This option includes 4% interest and .0285% interest charged by the credit card company.

\$11,962 tuition & fees = \$1,196 for 10 months

## **Other Terms and Conditions of Enrollment**

School Year – The 2021-22 school calendar is attached.

**School Day** – The first class will start at 8:00 a.m. Students arriving as early as 7:30 a.m. may come for a supervised Study Hall at no charge. Dismissal will be at 3:00 daily with option for daily Clubs & Sports.

**Alabama Immunization Card** – This state health card or a religious waiver *must* be on file in the school office before the first day of class in order for any student to attend.

**Admission Policy & Handbook** – All students attending Capitol School must comply with policies, rules, and Student Handbook as established by school faculty and administration.

**Sports & Clubs** – Sports teams were launched in 2013. During the pandemic, clubs allowed students to learn and practice without formal competition. The school bus or van provides transportation to sports practices and meets. Parents pick up their children after practice at the practice location or at the school. Students and parents will be informed at August Intake Conferences about choices, schedule and cost.

**Student Service Commitment**— Capitol School students are required to provide at least one hour of service to the school or one hour of service to the community each week.

9th Graders and High School Credit – This cluster bridges the traditional 8th & 9th grades. Our model is the hybrid undergraduate/graduate college courses in which the advanced students fulfill additional requirements in order to receive 9th grade credit on their high school transcripts.

**BYOD** – Each student must have an approved laptop with a maintenance plan in place for the laptop. *Google Classroom* is used to access assignments and turn in work online and for parents to view student progress/grades.

**Media Release** - Parents give permission for your child's photographs/videos to be used for information purposes within the school & for information about Capitol School's programs to the public through websites, videos, social media, publications, commercials, TV and newspapers/print media. If you do NOT wish for your child's images to be included, please send a signed note to the school office.

**Student Handbook** — All students must comply with the policies, rules and the Online Student Handbook established by school faculty. Please print and sign the contract's last page to affirm that you and your child have both read and agree to abide by the Capitol School Student Handbook.

**Student Service Commitment**— Capitol School students are required to provide at least one hour of service to the school or one hour of service to the community each week.

**Parent/Teacher Communication** – Required parent-teacher conferences are held in August, October & March. Additional conferences can be scheduled by appointment. Emails, texts and *REMIND* app are used to communication with parents.

Parent Council & Volunteer Hours – The Capitol School is a partnership of school and family. Membership in PTC is included. Parents/guardians agree to support your child's education by contributing one hour per week (36 hours per year). This time may be contributed weekly, monthly, or for an event such as fieldtrips, prom, or graduation. Attendance at Parent Council meetings and events count toward volunteer hours. Food drives for Soup Kitchen and Little Pantry to feed local children can count toward hours. Parents are responsible for keeping an online log of hours volunteered.
