This nonrefundable annual fee is payable by July 6 with the signed contract to secure your child's placement in The Capitol School for the 2018-19 academic year. If payment and visa information is not received by July 6, the student's enrollment will be cancelled.

- The first payment of \$500 must be paid prior to issue of I 20 for your child's F1 student visa and is due with the contract.
- A portion of the fee includes \$1,300 for the cost of a new Mac Airbook with *Microsoft Word* for Mac.
- Optional expenses: lunches ordered from restaurants, out-of-town fieldtrips, clubs or sports uniforms.

Annual Tuition: \$21,726.00 (8:30 – 3:30 p.m. Monday – Friday) Sports teams meet M-Th 3:45 – 5:15 p.m.

In consideration for The Capitol School's agreement to hold a class position for this student, the parents' obligation to pay the fees for the full academic year is unconditional. After July 6, 2018, no portion of the outstanding fees will be refunded or cancelled, in whole or in part, in case of absence, withdrawal, departure, suspension or expulsion from school. Any cancellation of enrollment must be in writing and received before July 6, 2018, to relieve the obligation of paying the tuition in full. Tuition includes ELL support for speakers whose first language is not English. Tuition does NOT include home-stay living arrangements with Tuscaloosa host families who are paid directly \$1,100 by the student's parents each month for room and board. Packed lunches can be brought from home at no charge OR lunch can be ordered from restaurants each day and that costs approximately \$110 per month. Tuition does NOT include college tuition to be paid directly to The University of Alabama.

The parents/guardians pay the annual tuition in one lump sum of \$21,726 due July 6, 2018. An extension can be granted until the visa process is completed in the student's home country.

Other Terms and Conditions of Enrollment

School Year – The recent online parent survey determined parent preferences for the 2018-19 school calendar.

Alabama Immunization Card – This blue health card *must* be on file in the school office before the first day of class in order for any student to attend. Parents should send complete health and immunization records with their child so that it can be transferred to the required Alabama form by a local doctor.

Admission Policy & Handbook – All students entering Capitol School must comply with policies, rules, and Student Handbook as established by school faculty and administration.

Student "Bank Account" - The Capitol School will maintain a student "bank account" for all international students to pay for graduation fee, lunches ordered from restaurants, club fees, sports uniforms and travel, out-of-town fieldtrips and tuition to The University of Alabama. Each student is expected to open an account with \$1,800 to cover these expenses throughout the school year. Parents will be notified if additional funds are required. Statements will be available online at the parents' RenWeb account.

Sports & Clubs – The Capitol School clubs will meet during the lunch period. Club fees range from \$50 - \$100 per quarter. Sports teams practice after school from 3:45 – 5:15 p.m. Eleven sports team were launched in 2013. The school's bus and van provide transportation to off-campus sports facilities for volleyball, bowling, golf, tennis, track and soccer.

Media Release - Parents give permission for your child's photographs/videos to be used for information purposes within the school and to provide information about The Capitol School's programs to the public through websites, videos, social media, publications, commercials, newspapers/print media and television. If you do NOT wish for your child's images to be included, please scan a signed note and email the note to the school.

Student Handbook – All students must comply with the policies, rules and the Online Student Handbook established by school faculty. Please print and sign the contract's last page to affirm that you and your child have both read and agree to abide by the Capitol School Student Handbook.

Dual Enrollment/Dual Credit -- Since 1977, we have participated in the State of Alabama's Dual Enrollment/Dual Credit Program. To be eligible, the high school student must be 15+ years old and maintain a 3.0 GPA or higher to enroll at The University of Alabama's *Early College*. In addition, parents pay the college tuition, books and fees.

Student Service Commitment– College admission policies consider service an important part of a student's experiences. Capitol School students are required to provide at least one hour of service to the school or one hour of service to the community each week. Club participation is considered part of this student service commitment.

Entire Agreement - This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between The Capitol School and the undersigned, and supersedes all prior discussions and agreements between the parties, whether oral or written. The Capitol School shall not be bound by any understanding, agreement, promise, or representation concerning any matter, whether expressed or implied, not specified herein.
